Winner of the Flottweg World Cup Tipping Game Donates €500 to Children's Cancer Charity

On September 21, Georg Eierkaufner donated €500 to Kinderkrebshilfe Dingolfing-Landau-Landshut e.V. in Vilsbiburg. The Flottweg employee had won the amount earlier this year in the company's online World Cup Tipping Game.
