Purpose: Manage projects for new equipment purchases while acting as a technical resource

Responsibilities:

- Act as primary customer contact for coordination, design, and installation support over a four-to-twelve-month project life cycle from order to delivery.
- Manage the scope, schedule, and budget for multiple open projects at one time.
- Prepare submittal documents for complete delivery package including all required supporting documentation.
- Perform calculations to size and specify required process equipment such as pumps, instrumentation, tanks, and piping.
- Develop P&IDs, design concepts, and cost estimates to support the Sales Group.
- Support the Process Group during startup and obtain feedback on necessary design changes.
- Learn the capabilities, features and benefits of the entire product line.
- Coordinate internally to diagnose and troubleshoot equipment problems.
- Travel with process technicians periodically to become exposed to customers and applications in the various regions and markets.

Qualifications:

- BS in Engineering and previous project management experience in a similar field.
- This role will require a well-rounded understanding of mechanical, electrical/controls, and process systems.
- The position will require the candidate to become an internal expert of the equipment and the processes/systems of our customers.
- Experience in municipal wastewater, oil and gas, animal rendering, bioethanol, food and beverage, or pharmaceutical industries are a plus.
- English fluency required. Spanish, French, German, or Portuguese language skills are a plus.
